

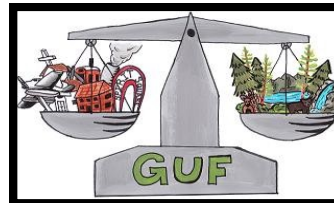

This brochure is designed to inform the people of Fort St. James of all the recycling opportunities and locations in Fort St. James!



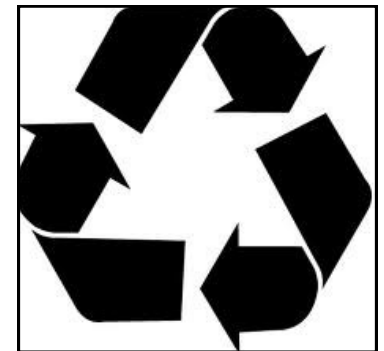

Cardboard

The Cardboard recycling bins are located next to the bottle depot, behind Fields. These bins are picked up a couple times a month!

Open 7:30am to 7:30pm 7 days a week!

Flattened Corrugated Cardboard only! This includes egg cartons!



No Waxed Cardboard, Styrofoam, garbage!

Mixed Paper

Also located beside the Bottle Depot!

Open 7:30am-7:30pm 7 days a week!

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Office Paper (staples okay)
- Wrapping Paper
- Envelopes (plastic windows okay)
- Cereal boxes/Cracker boxes



No Plastic, garbage, or dirty paper towels!

Other recycling options in FSJ:

- Plastic Bags: Overwaitea Foods
- Drink Bottle/Cans/Milk Jugs: Bottle Depot
- Tires: KaI-Tire
- All Printer Ink/Cartridges/Computers: Max IT
- Oil/Filters/Oil Containers: Riverside Repairs/ Stuart Lake Automotive Specialist
- Anti-Freeze: Riverside Repairs
- Medication (All over the counter and prescription): Lakeside Pharmacy
- Used Batteries/Cell Phones: Nechako Valley Electronics/District office

Fort St. James Waste Transfer Station: AKA The Dump

- Grass Clippings/Leaves: compost pile
- Residual paint products including aerosol cans
- Appliances: \$16 charge for appliances still containing Freon.
- Metals: propane tanks, crushed clean food cans, auto hulks (some restrictions: contact Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako)
- Clean Wood Waste: untreated/no paint/no stain
- Glass-clean food jars
- Auto batteries
- Reusable household items: reuse shed

Did You Know?

- **FSJ creates 1900 metric tonnes of waste a year!**
- **That 24% of that waste is cardboard and mixed paper! 456MT/year or 38MT/month**
- **Since November FSJ has diverted 11 metric tonnes of cardboard and mixed paper!**
- **The paper and cardboard is taken to Cascade recovery in Vancouver where it goes to make paper towel, tissue paper, fine paper, packaging products and various other consumer products.**
